In the street we have seen this girl.	You've just seen a girl? Where is she?
She has been so wet because she hasn't had an umbrella.	Why? It hasn't rained here for two weeks and Tiffany is still wet?
I have given her my jacket!	The jacket that Tiffany is wearing is Dennis' jacket? He has got a pink jacket? With glitter? German boys are strange!!

Why didn't the girls understand Dennis?

Because he used the present perfect!

The present perfect always takes us from the past to the present!
